



Collecting Demographic Information from Families in Your Program

This document provides a sample letter that a program might send to families to gather demographic information for the first time. The letter informs families about why the program collects demographic information and aims to alleviate families' concerns. Sample demographic survey questions are offered for your consideration. In creating your survey, only use the questions for the demographic information you need for analysis or evaluation reporting. In your letter, you might provide examples of how your program will use the demographic information (e.g., use of culturally responsive practices, providing materials in children's home language, continuous program improvement). After your program has collected demographic information for the first time, you can plan to add these questions to the annual enrollment packet for families.

Sample Letter

Your team will want to revise what is below to fit your program.

At Sunshine Early Learners, we are committed to creating a supportive and nurturing environment where each child in our program can thrive. To further this commitment, we have decided to collect demographic information about children and families, including gender, race, and home language. Collecting demographic information will help us understand the diversity of the children we are supporting and help our program meet the needs of each and every child. The information will help us better support your child and family.

We are sending you this brief survey to initiate this process. Participation in the survey is voluntary, and we will keep the information you provide confidential. If you choose not to share this information with us, we respect your decision, and it will not impact your child's enrollment.

We understand that you might have concerns, and we want to reassure you that the information will be used solely to enhance our program. The information you share will help us ensure quality and equity, particularly around implementing the Pyramid Model.
