

Local Program Indicators and Elements of High-Quality Inclusion

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This brief data report summarizes Local Program Indicators and Elements of High-Quality Inclusion (field test version) measured between 2021 and 2023 for four early childhood programs supported by two Oregon Community Inclusion Teams in cohort 1. For this report, data from all 4 programs were averaged across to represent overall implementation of the Indicators of High-Quality Inclusion.

Overall Summary of Local Program Indicators

Figure 1 shows that the percentage of indicators not in place decreased from 22% to 9% between 2021 and 2023. Additionally, the percentage of fully implemented indicators grew from 21% to 23% during this period. Despite a seemingly small growth in fully implemented indicators, this is attributed to a higher percentage of partially implemented indicators in 2023 compared to previous years.

Implementation Progress by Program Indicator

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Twelve indicators were considered at the program level: Inclusion Leadership Team (ILT), Vision (VIS), Family Engagement and Partnership (FEP), Awareness and Commitment (AC), Policies and Procedures (PP), Collaborative Teaming (CT), Fiscal Resources (FR), Personnel Policies and Structure (PPS), Specialized Technical Assistance and Consultative Services (STACS), Program Supports for Professional Development (PSPD), Curriculum (C), and Data Collection and Use (DCU).

Table 2 presents the average progress made between 2021 and 2023 for the implementation of each local program indicator. As of 2023, none of the indicators have been fully implemented for any of the local programs. Nevertheless, two indicators to date are currently in the planning stage and most initiated the implementation process.


As depicted in Figure 3, advancements in the implementation of seven indicators have been observed in 2023 compared to previous years. Vision (VIS), Policies and Procedures (PP), Collaborative Teaming (CT), Specialized Technical Assistance and Consultative Services (STACS), Program Supports for Professional Development (PSPD), Curriculum (C) and Data Collection and Use (DCU) are all indicators have begun implementation in all programs. Of note, there has been an overall increase in indicator implementation, with all program indicators being partially implemented at this point in 2023. However, none are fully implemented indicating need for further support.

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Conclusion

In general, the majority of indicators have been partially implemented across programs. Currently, only two indicators [Family Engagement and Partnership (FEP), and Awareness and Commitment (AC)], remain in the planning stage. While no indicator has achieved full implementation on average, there has been an increase in the percentage of indicators in the partial implementation stage in 2023 compared to preceding years. The data analyzed in this report indicates a gradual improvement over time in the implementation of high-quality inclusion program indicators.

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
